Who was Albert Schweitzer?

Albert Schweitzer, born in Kayzersberg in 1875, is an emblematic figure of humanism. A doctor, theologian, musician and philosopher, he devoted his life to humanitarian aid and the promotion of peace. Winner of the Nobel Peace Prize in 1952, he is best known for his medical work in Africa, where he founded a hospital in Lambaréné, Gabon. His commitment to freedom, tolerance and mutual respect continues to inspire generations around the world.
